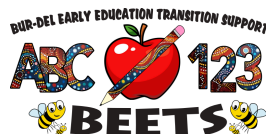
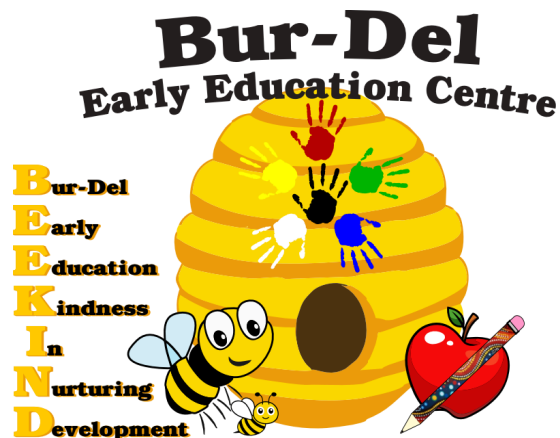


Our program offers:

- Support for families to apply for NDIS funding if needed
- An early education program guided by the Early Years Framework: Foundations for Success and developmental input from Occupational and Speech Therapists
- Support for families to access other early education services and to complete enrolment applications
- Support for families and children during the transition to school process
- Bus service for your child to and from the Centre
- Bus service for eligible families to attend community appointments

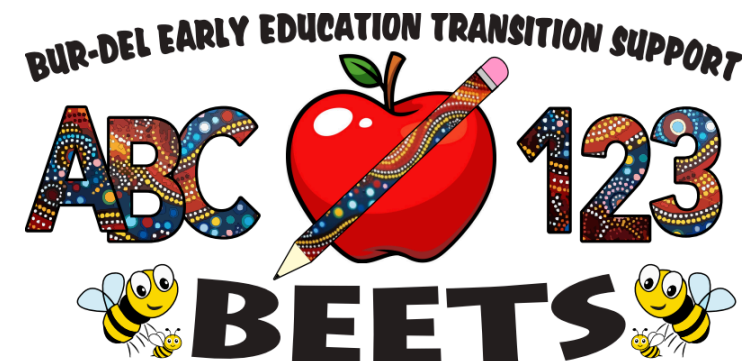

Who is the program for ?

Aboriginal, Torres Strait Islander and South Sea Islander children aged 3-5 years (not yet eligible for Prep)

Sessions

Sessions run during school terms only

Children are grouped according to the year they will start Prep

Children attend one session each week.

Pre-Kindy:

Mon or Tues 9-11a.m or 1-3pm

Pre-Prep:

Wed or Thurs 9a.m-2p.m

What to bring

- a healthy snack plus lunch (lunch for long session only)
- water bottle
- hat
- spare change of clothes
- pullups (if needed)
